- 1) (a) Identify and explain the range of negative social impacts which may arise from transport in an urban built environment context. [5 marks]
- (b) The UK government has set a target of 2035 for converting the UK private vehicle fleet to electric vehicles. Discuss how effective this intervention would be in managing the negative social impacts of private car use in an urban built environment context. (~750 words) [20 marks]
- 2) (a) Explain the principles of an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) and identify which development projects require an EIA to be undertaken. [5 marks]
- (b) Discuss the concept of Strategic Environmental Assessment (SEA) and how it differs from and complements traditional EIA processes. (~750 words) [20 marks]
- 3) (a) Define the concept of 'bio-diversity' and explain why it is important. [5 marks]
- (b) 'Green belts' are areas of land given specific planning protection. Evaluate the role of the English 'green belt policy' in promoting or improving biodiversity. (~750 words) [20 marks]
- 4) (a) Identify and explain three different types of flooding. [5 marks]
- (b) Flood risk is expected to increase because of climate change. Debate how effective you think current planning policy is in England in controlling flood risk. (~750 words) [20 marks]
