At CATÓLICA-LISBON, exchange students don't follow a specific Master program or study plan. Instead, we offer a list of courses from several scientific areas and fields of study in order exchange students can have a wide and diversified course offer that can better suit their needs.

For Fall 2022 the course list will only became available online in mid-end of June/beginning of July 2022 and for Spring 2023 the course list will only became available online in mid-end of December 2022/beginning of January 2023. Nevertheless, our course offer only suffers slight changes from semester to semester. As such, students can check the courses' list of the Spring and Fall Semesters of previous Academic Years for their reference. This way they can easily have a general overview of our subjects and check, along with the Academic Advisor of their home universities, which courses will better match their study plans.

- . 3rd and 4th Trimesters to check trimester-long courses offered in Spring 2022 and 2nd Semester for semester-long courses offered in Spring 2022.
- All courses are taught in English.
- If you click on the name of the course you are automatically redirected to the course's page where you can download the syllabus in a pdf document.
- Immediately below the course's name you have information about the number of <u>ECTS</u> granted by each course as well as the <u>Pre-Requisites*</u> of the courses.
- We offer Language Courses that are optional and paid separately.
- Students can take 28 ECTS in regular courses + 1 Language Course (optional & paid), in a total of 33 ECTS maximum.
- There are no mandatory courses for Erasmus/Exchange students.

*It is also important to mention that we do not verify if incoming exchange students fulfil the prerequisites of the courses, as this is the responsibility of the exchange students to verify their study plan requirements with their Home Universities before enrolling in our courses. In case of any issues with the students' course choices, we are unable to accommodate or rearrange the students' study plans after the adjustment periods. Therefore, students are required to check in beforehand with their Academic Advisors, for example by taking a close look at the syllabi, if they took any course at their Home Universities that allowed them to have enough background to successfully follow the courses of their interest at CATÓLICA-LISBON.

Attendance to classes is mandatory and we have absence control. As such, overlapping of schedule is not allowed.

Please have in mind that course enrolment is made on a "first-come, first-served" policy. As such, we do not guarantee slots in courses.

The Master Academic Calendar is organized in trimesters. Specifically, the 1st Semester comprises the 1st and 2nd Trimesters and the 2nd Semester comprises the 3rd and 4th Trimesters. Please see document attached.

Students can take up to 4 trimester-long courses per trimester in a total of 8 trimester-long courses per semester (1 semester corresponds to 2 trimesters).

Semester-long courses occupy a course slot in two trimesters (they count twice). Meaning that they are equivalent in taking 2 trimester-long courses, one in each trimester.

Example (just for reference):

1st Trimester/3rd Trimester

Business Ethics and Social Responsibility (3.5 ECTS)
Consumer Behaviour (3.5 ECTS)
Critical Thinking in Management (3.5 ECTS)
Marketing Research (7 ECTS) or another trimester-long course of 3.5 ECTS

2nd Trimester/4th Trimester

Brand Management (3.5 ECTS)

Banking and Regulation (3.5 ECTS)

Business Analytics (3.5 ECTS)

Marketing Research (7 ECTS) or another trimester-long course of 3.5 ECTS

Usually, in October students have exams concerning the 1st Trimester courses and in December exams concerning the trimester-long courses they are enrolled for on the 2nd trimester and semester-long courses from the 1st Semester.

In March students have exams concerning the 3rd Trimester courses and in May/June exams concerning the trimester-long courses they are enrolled for on the 4th trimester and semester-long courses from the 2nd Semester.
